Information, Reports and Recommendations

Dr. Hazel Frick reviewed the Adequate Yearly Progress (AYP) school status results and ABC results for 2008-2009. Five out of the eight schools met adequate yearly progress: Balfour, Teachey, Lindley Park, North Asheboro Middle and South Asheboro Middle.

Dr. Dot Harper reported on procedures for Asheboro City Schools' *No Child Left Behind* School Choice Plan for the 2009-2010 school year and presented public school choice options. The three schools offering school choice will be McCrary, Balfour and Donna L. Loflin. The choice transfer schools will be Teachey and Lindley Park.

Dr. Frick presented Policy 4400 – Attendance, for 30-day review. The policy defines and explains regulations related to attendance records, excused and excessive absences, tardies, and assignments missed due to school-related activities. A proposed change has been presented reducing the number of days an Asheboro High School student can be absent and earn course credit per semester from eight days to four days. This change is recommended in order to further limit the amount of instructional time that can be missed due to absence from school.

Dr. Frost reviewed information on a feasibility study for the Old Balfour Early Childhood Development Center presented at the Board Retreat by Mr. John Sinnett of Smith, Sinnett Architecture. The two options being considered are to replace the old sections of old Balfour and renovate the three newer sections or provide an entire new building. The Board also discussed using mobile classrooms to house classes until funds become available to build a new facility. After further discussion, the Board directed the Administration to request a meeting with County Commissioners to assess the availability of

assistance to fund the project and a possible timeline.

Action Items

Dr. Frost presented the Board of Education Goals for 2009-2010. The five main goals are high student achievement, quality teachers, administrators and staff, healthy students in safe, orderly and caring schools, strong family, business, and community support, and effective and efficient operations. The Board unanimously approved the goals as presented.

Following a review by the State Department of Public Instruction of a bid submitted by Sodexo, Inc., to manage the Asheboro City Schools' child nutrition program, the Board awarded Sodexo the 2009-2010 Food Service Management Contract.

Following a 30-day review, the Board unanimously approved the following policies: Policy 4316 – Standard of Appearance of Clothing; Policy 5040 – News Media Relations; Policy 6524 – Network Security; and Policy 7920 – Professional Personnel Reduction in Force.

Superintendent's Report/Calendar of Events

Dr. Frost reviewed the process taken in preparing the 2009-2010 Budget. Steps were taken to ensure no loss of jobs for any Asheboro City Schools employee. Lost positions were handled by resignations, retirements and federal funding. Class sizes in all grades still exceed state expectations.

Ms. Carla Freemyer shared the Calendar of Events highlighting the following: Convocation, August 20, 7:30 a.m.; Family Alliance Network FAN Fair, August 29, 9:00 a.m. to 1:00 p.m.; and New Employee Reception, September 9, 4:00 p.m., at the Professional Development Center.

Board Operations

Chairman Kidd informed board members that the North Carolina School Boards Association's District 5 meeting will be held at West Stokes High School in King, N. C. September 30, from 4:00 p.m. to 8:00 p.m.

Executive Session

The Board entered closed session at 8:55 p.m. to conduct the Superintendent's annual Performance Review for 2008-2009.

Adjournment

There being no further business, the meeting adjourned at 9:45 p.m.
