Information, Reports, and Recommendations

Ms. Donna Clelland presented newly proposed Policy 4153 – School Improvement Choice Transfer, for 30-day review. The policy defines and clarifies the guidelines for school choice transfers and includes the criteria for eligible schools, the transfer procedures, notification timelines, transportation requirements, the length of the transfer and receiving school responsibilities.

Action Items

After a 30-day review, the Board unanimously approved Policy 4126 – Homeless Students which defines homelessness and removes barriers for homeless students.

Dr. Diane Frost presented an overview of a teacher assistant reduction plan. Due to a reduction in teacher position allotments and related funding issues, there is a need to reduce teacher assistant positions for 2007-2008 by six. After entering executive session for further clarification, the Board voted 9 to 1 in favor of the reduction plan with Mr. Kyle Lamb being opposed to the motion.

Superintendent's Report/Calendar of Events

Dr. Frost invited board members to attend a public forum on dropout reform hosted by legislators. The forum will be held July 26th, 6:00 p.m., at North Asheboro Middle School.
