Information, Reports and Recommendations

Dr. Diane Frost and the administration highlighted milestones reached by Asheboro City Schools during the 2008-2009 school year noting goals reached in the areas of high student achievement; quality teachers, administrators and staff; healthy students in safe, orderly and caring schools; strong family, business and community support; and effective and efficient operations.

Dr. Hazel Frick presented the following policies for 30day review: Policy 4316, Standard of Appearance or Clothing – A change has been made to the terminology. The word, "school," was replaced by the word, "district," to indicate that the policy is applicable not only to individual schools but to the district as a whole; Policy 5040, News Media Relations - The policy has been revised slightly to include a policy number and title (Public Records - Retention, Release and Disposition); Policy 6524, Network Security - It is a proposed new policy addressing system integrity and security since sensitive and confidential information may be stored in these systems; and Policy 7920, Professional Personnel Reduction in Force - This policy has been revised to update the existing procedure for reducing the number of licensed, professional employees of the school district. establishes grounds for reduction in force that include system reorganization, declining enrollment, and financial exigency. After preliminary determination based on established criteria has been made, a procedure for termination is described. The policy revision complies with the North Carolina School Boards Association's Policy 7920.

Following a 30-day review, the Board unanimously approved one revised policy and two new policies: Policy 3225/4312/7320 – Technology Acceptable Use; Policy 3227/7322 – Web Page Development; and Policy 4318 – Wireless Communication Devices.
