### **Information, Reports and Recommendations**

Dr. Hazel Frick presented the following policies for 30-day review: Policy 3405, *Students At-Risk of Academic Failure* – The policy requires schools to identify students that are at risk of academic failure and are not successfully progressing toward grade promotion and graduation. This new policy includes developing a personal education plan for academic improvement no later than the end of the first instructional period of the school year; Policy 3420, *Student Promotion and Accountability* – Changes have been made to remove the North Carolina gateway requirements and now reflects current local requirements in Asheboro City Schools; and Policy 3460, *Graduation Requirements* – Updates include the elimination of student accountability gateways and high school exit standards and will include local requirements to reflect current practice in Asheboro City Schools.

### **Action Items**

Following a 30-day review, board members unanimously approved the following board policies: Policy 1510/4200/7270, *School Safety* and Policy 2121, *Board Member Conflict of Interest*.

Superintendent Frost presented the 2011-2012 Board Goals for approval. The Board unanimously approved the goals as presented.

Following recent action taken by legislation, General Statute 115C-84.2, which now requires 185 instructional days, Dr. Tim Allgood requested board approval of a revised 2011-2012 school calendar. LEA's may apply for a waiver to the new 185-day requirement for the 2011-2012 school year and request the 5 days be used for professional development on the new essential standards and Common Core standards. The Board unanimously approved October 7 and June 8 as instructional days and January 18, March 2, and April 23 as teacher workdays for professional development.

### **Superintendent's Report/Calendar of Events**

Carla Freemyer shared the Calendar of Events highlighting the following dates: Convocation, August 19, 2011; NCSBA 5<sup>th</sup> District Meeting, September 21, 2011; Adequate Yearly Progress preliminary release, July 21, 2011; and 2011 Dog Park Challenge Judging Ceremony, July 28, 2011 at Balfour Elementary.

### **Executive Session**

The Board and Superintendent entered executive session to review performance standards, annual goals/milestones and self-evaluation.

### **Open Session**

The Board nominated Dr. Diane Frost to be a candidate for the 2011 A. Craig Phillips North Carolina Superintendent of the Year. The superintendent selected for this distinction will then represent North Carolina as the 2012 AASA National Superintendent of the Year candidate.

### **Adjournment**

There being no further business, the meeting adjourned at 7:45 p.m.
