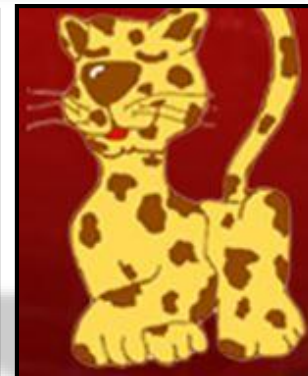


100th Day of School at Lindley Park
