Transfer Process Opens March 1

Attention employees who would like to transfer students to Asheboro City Schools for the 2017-18 school year: Releases from Randolph County Schools must be completed between 2/15-3/30. An application for admission to Asheboro City Schools must be completed between 3/1-6/1. **If this is the first year a parent is applying for release or admission, they will not be sent an email or an application in the mail.** They must go on-line to complete Randolph County School's paperwork and see Tena Lester to complete an Asheboro City Schools form. Again, the process does not open for Asheboro City Schools until March 1.
