Asheboro Students Advance to North Carolina Math Fair Competition

ASHEBORO – The North Carolina Council of Teachers of Mathematics hosted the Central Region Math Fair last Saturday (March 18) at North Asheboro Middle School. Approximately 109 participants from 23 schools across the central region attended the fair. Asheboro City Schools had eight students place in the competition, who will now advance to the North Carolina Math Fair competition on Friday, April 28 in Durham, NC.

Winning students from Asheboro City Schools included: Jeannette Graham from North Asheboro Middle School and Rolando Hernandez from South Asheboro Middle School won in Honorable Mention Middle School Division; Freddy Kelley from South Asheboro Middle School medaled in Honorable Mention Middle School Division; Will Kelley and Jackson Greene both from South Asheboro Middle School placed third in the Intermediate Division; Jonah Hydzik and Nicholas Paschal both from Asheboro High School medaled in the Honorable Mention High School Division; and Malachi Clark from Asheboro High School placed second in the High School Division.
