Asheboro City Schools Athletics Game Sponsor - Overview and Guidelines

Purpose:

To raise revenue in support of the interscholastic athletic program in Asheboro City Schools;

To encourage organizations and businesses in Asheboro and Randolph County to advertise at interscholastic athletic events.

Sponsor Information:

- 1. Game sponsorships are available upon request and must be approved according to Board of Education Policy 5240 Advertising in the Schools.
- 2. Game sponsorships are available for \$250.00. For the 2013 2014 fall sports season.
- 3. Sponsors may set up in the designated place in the stadium between 5:45 and 6:00 and remain through the conclusion of the game. The sponsor will be responsible for their own table and other set-up materials.
- 3. Game sponsorships include:
 - 12' x 15' advertisement space at the stadium entrance.
 - Four (4) 15-second public address announcements to be aired during each quarter.
 - Sponsorship of the starting lineups ("And now, Blue Comets' fans, tonight's starting lineups sponsored by Name of organization or business.")
- 4. Game sponsors may distribute promotional items, sample products, promote specials, and/or discuss their products with fans.
- 5. Game sponsors (as indicated in Board of Education Policy 5240 Advertising in the Schools) are prohibited from advertising that:
 - Is vulgar, indecent, or obscene;
 - Contains libelous statements, personal attacks or abusive language;
 - Causes a disruption of a school activity;
 - Encourages the commission of unlawful acts or the violation of school regulations;
 - Is inappropriate considering the age of the students in the school;
 - Includes information that is false or inaccurate; or,
 - Advertises any product not permitted to minors by law.
