 Attendance (missing eight or more unexcused days from school) Your child has until the end of the semester to correct this violation or complete a Driver's Eligibility Hardship Request Form that you must contact the school and meet with to receive. Failure to respond to this request will result in the immediate notification to the department of motor vehicles for surrender of your child's driving permit or license. If you make a hardship request, you will be notified within 10 working days of the approval or denial of your hardship request. If your request is denied we will immediately notify the Department of Motor Vehicles that you're driving permit or driver's license should be surrendered. The Department of Motor Vehicles will officially notify you that your driver's license privilege is revoked.
