## **Opening**

Chairman Jones called the meeting to order and welcomed all in attendance.

The Board unanimously approved a revised meeting agenda. Personnel appointments were moved under Action Items.

#### **Information, Reports and Recommendations**

Brad Rice, Director of Support Services, reported on school safety in Asheboro City Schools. Mr. Rice stated that the number of reported acts per 1,000 students decreased from 11.2 percent for the 2005-2006 school year to 7.5 percent for the 2006-2007 school year. Chief Gary Mason, along with School Resource Officers Charles Voncannon, Bradley Sudduth, Charles Perrin and Jason Creek expressed their dedication to ensuring the safety of the students of Asheboro City Schools.

Dr. Dot Harper, Assistant Superintendent of Curriculum and Instruction, shared information on advanced placement exam performance history noting there has been an increase in the total number of students taking AP exams over the past five years.

Dr. Harper reported on the No Child Left Behind Choice Report for Balfour Elementary School. Of the 23 students who were granted school choice in 2006-2007 three of the students were promoted to 6<sup>th</sup> grade, one student opted to return to Balfour Elementary, 13 students chose to remain at Loflin Elementary, five students chose to go to McCrary and one student is no longer in the system. For the 2007-2008 school year eleven students, representing eight families, have opted for school choice. One student will be attending McCrary Elementary and 10 students will be attending Loflin Elementary.

Dr. Allgood shared information on teacher recruitment for 2007. A total of 39 teachers have been hired for the 2007-2008 school year. Twenty-six of those teachers are from North Carolina and thirteen are from out-of-state.

## **Action Items**

The Board of Education upheld the decision of the Superintendent to deny the release of a student from Asheboro City Schools.

The Board approved personnel appointments by a vote of 8 to 3 with Ms. Kidd, Mr. Robbins and Mr. Lamb voting no.
