#### Information, Reports, and Recommendations

County Manager, Richard Wells, reported on a proposal from the Randolph County Board of Commissioners to increase sales tax <sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> cent.

Ms. Donna Clelland presented the following policies for 30 day review:

- Policy 2126/4705/7825, Confidentiality of Personal Identifying Information – Proposed new policy to protect volunteers, board members, students and employees from the improper release of personal identifying information including social security numbers.
- Policy 4400, Attendance The proposed changes will clarify a valid educational opportunity, add pregnancy and parenting to the list of excused absences, and update legal references.

Dr. Dot Harper and Ms. Nancy Moody updated the Board on the Reading First program at McCrary Elementary School. McCrary will withdraw from the Reading First program and join other elementary schools in the Balanced Literacy program beginning with the 2008-2009 school year.

Ms. Gail Hicks, Director of Exceptional Child Services, highlighted Asheboro City Schools' Continuous Improvement Performance Plan indicators for 2006-2007.
