Action Items

Board members approved a request to use Memorial Day as an inclement weather makeup day in the remaining 2010-2011 school year. Use of this holiday would be an absolute last resort after using four other days that have been designated as makeup days.

Dr. Tim Allgood presented the 2012-2013 Calendar as recommended by the Calendar Committee for board approval. Board members unanimously approved the calendar as presented. School will begin for students on August 27 and end June 7.

Members of the Board approved a 2011 Career & Technical Education Strategic Plan introduced to them at their Winter Retreat on February 5. It is aligned with Asheboro City Schools 2011 Strategic Plan.
