Information, Reports, and Recommendations

Dr. Tim Allgood presented the Teacher Turnover Report for 2006-2007. As of June 30, 2007, the rate of teacher turnover was 13% for the school system. Dr. Allgood shared the primary reason for teachers leaving the system is to teach in another North Carolina LEA.

Dr. Allgood provided information on an expanded advanced degree reimbursement plan for staff and shared the objectives, eligibility and selection criteria, course eligibility, application process and selection. Employees will be notified at the beginning of this school year in school-level staff meetings.

Dr. Allgood reported on the 2006-2007 athletic program. Asheboro City Schools sponsored over 50 teams last year. Twelve of the varsity teams were recognized by the North Carolina High School Athletic Association as scholarathlete teams. North Asheboro Middle School and Asheboro High School received the Conference Sportsmanship Award.

Action Items

Dr. Diane Frost presented the Board of Education Goals for 2007-2008. The goals were reviewed by the Board at its Fall Retreat. The Board unanimously approved the goals.

Dr. Frost presented for board approval a 5-year lease between the Asheboro City Board of Education and Randolph Community Services, Inc. The lease agreement was unanimously approved by the Board.

After a 30-day review, the Board unanimously approved Policy 4153 - School Improvement Choice Transfer. The policy defines and clarifies the guidelines for school choice transfers. Ms. Janice Kite, Lead Teacher and K-5 Literacy Coordinator, presented report card change proposals for kindergarten through second grade. The request for the change will match the report card to the current writing workshop curriculum. The Board unanimously approved the request.

Superintendent's Report/Calendar of Events

Ms. Carla Freemyer shared the Calendar of Events noting several important dates as follows: Board Candidate Workshop, September 5; Board/Superintendent Leadership Session, September 11; Breakfast and Convocation, August 24; Teachey Ribbon Cutting, August 29; New Employee Reception, September 4; and the Asheboro High School Zoo School Ribbon Cutting, September 12.

Board Operations/Committee Reports

Dr. Frost presented information on Master Board courses that are available through the North Carolina School Boards Association. The Board will begin a series of courses starting 2008.

There were no nominations made by the Board for the Raleigh Dingman Award which will be presented during the Awards Ceremony of the Annual NCSBA Conference.

Dr. Frost reminded the Board of the NCSBA district meeting to be held September 19, 2007 in Winston-Salem, North Carolina.

Executive Session

The Board entered executive session at 8:35 p.m. to review the Superintendent's evaluation.

Following executive session, the Board approved the Superintendent's performance review for 2006-2007 and accepted changes to the Superintendent's contract effective July 1, 2007.

Adjournment

The meeting adjourned at 10:15 p.m.
