



We will use this information during our admission review process and historically submission of this information has made a significant contribution to our decision to admit a student.

Thank you for your interest in Appalachian State University!

A complete application includes the following:

- 1. First-year** - For purposes of admission, Appalachian defines First-year as those students entering direct from high school or those who have not earned enough college credits after high school graduation to be considered for admission as a transfer student. (NOTE: Early College High School students currently must apply as freshman).
 - a. \$65 non-refundable application fee
 - b. Copy of official high school transcript (grades 9 - 12)
 - c. SAT or ACT results
 - d. College transcripts, if you have attended any college (dual-enrollment, Early College High School, online courses, etc.), mail to Office of Admissions, Appalachian State University, ASU Box 32004, Boone, NC 28608-2004
 - e. Application deadlines

- 2. Transfer** - For purposes of admission, transfer applicants must present a minimum of 30 transferable semester credits (completed or in progress of completion) from a regionally accredited institution; this credit must be earned after graduation from high school. Transfer students must have a minimum overall transferable grade point average (GPA) of 2.25 (on a 4.0 scale). Potential transfer students must have successfully completed a high school curriculum that meets the UNC Minimum Course Requirements (MCR) and be eligible from a conduct or an academic eligibility perspective to return to their last college/university attended.
 - a. \$65 non-refundable application fee
 - b. Official final high school transcript, High School Equivalency Diploma or Adult high school diploma
 - c. Official College transcripts from all colleges/universities ever attended (whether coursework was completed or not), including a list of courses/coursework in progress and which includes course titles, course numbers, and credit hours attempted.
 - d. Application deadline: <http://admissions.appstate.edu/how-apply/transfer-students-0>
- Second Degree Seeking** - For purposes of admission, a second undergraduate degree applicant is one who has earned a bachelor's degree from any regionally accredited institution.
 - a. \$65 non-refundable application fee
 - b. Official College transcript from post-secondary school where bachelor's degree was earned
 - c. Application deadline: Rolling Admission
- Non-Degree/Visiting** - For purposes of admission, a non-degree student is one who does not plan to pursue a degree and for whom will be admitted for one term only.
 - a. \$65 non-refundable application fee


